Department – Internal Medicine

- Management of over 1800 patients during unselected acute medical take in emergency department as a registrar.
- This includes acute thrombolysis for around 10 patients with acute stroke, management of over 50 cardiac arrests as a team leader, temporary transcatheter pacing for complete heart block.
- Consultant post-take of over 900 patients presenting with different medical conditions including sepsis, acute coronary syndrome, heart failure, hypertensive emergencies, acute stroke, respiratory tract infections like pneumonia and covid pneumonitis, type 2 respiratory failure requiring NIV support, acute kidney injury, upper GI bleed falls, drug overdose.
- Medical management of over 5000 inpatients during daily ward rounds, on general medical ward with patients presenting with sepsis, diabetic ketoacidosis, pneumonia, infective exacerbations of asthma or COPD, heart failure, discitis, urosepsis, infective endocarditis, covid pneumonitis, c.difficile infection, meningitis, delirium, pyrexia of unknown origin.

- Clinical experience of managing over 1400 patients with diabetes including type 1 diabetes, type 2 diabetes, type 3c diabetes, LADA and MODY and managing microvascular and macrovascular complication.
- Clinical expertise of managing patients on insulin pumps including hybrid closed loop system, continuous glucose monitoring system like Libre and Dexcom, especially in pregnant women.
- Experience of managing approximately 3000 patients with endocrine disorders including metabolic syndrome, thyroid dysfunction, primary hyperparathyroidism, post-surgical hypoparathyroidism, adrenal insufficiency, cushing's, primary aldosteronism, pheochromocytoma, pituitary adenoma, acromegaly, pan-hypopituitarism and hypogonadism.
- Experience of managing over 1000 pregnant women in antenatal clinic with gestational diabetes or type 1 or type 2 diabetes in pregnancy or thyroid or parathyroid conditions in pregnancy.
- Organizing and interpretation of dynamic function tests like short synacthen test for adrenal insufficiency, saline suppression test for primary aldosteronism, water deprivation test for polydipsia & polyuria, glucagon stimulation test for growth hormone deficiency, glucose tolerance test for acromegaly, prolonged supervised fasting for work-up of insulinoma.
- Work-up for adrenal incidentalomas and pituitary adenomas
- Management of over 30 patients with post-bariatric surgery complications like reactive hypoglycemia and dumping syndrome.
- Leading the bariatric multidisciplinary team meetings for medical management of patients with obesity under Tier3 weight management service, including initiation of GLP-1 and GIP receptor agonists in over 120 patients, and patients under Tier 4 service undergoing bariatric surgery.
